# ABOUT TORONTO MUDDY YORK RFC



Founded in 2003, Muddy York RFC is Canada's longest running mixed abilities rugby team. Based in Toronto, Ontario, we are dedicated to being a welcoming club, open for everyone to experience the wonderful sport of rugby, regardless of their sexuality, race, gender identity, or ability. Our club and supporters represent a diverse range of communities, including 2SLGBTQIA+ individuals, immigrants, first-generation Canadians, first-time athletes, seasoned jocks, singers, artists, academics, entrepreneurs, medical professionals, and veterans.

As we are one team with three pillars — M+ Contact, W+ Contact, and Co-Ed Mixed Abilities — we offer multiple pathways for our members and community to enjoy the sport and camaraderie of rugby. Social and competitive games are played over the spring and summer months, along with other social and training opportunities in the fall and winter. Our goal is to use the values taught by rugby to show that sports are for all people. We value teamwork, leadership, philanthropy, friendship, and passion both on and off the pitch.

At Muddy York, our ethos is simple: "With You!" It is a powerful rugby phrase which reminds us that on the pitch, you are never alone — there is always someone by your side to support you. Off the pitch, it represents the commitment we share with one another, it means finding community in a new city, marching at Pride, volunteering at the local food bank, and supporting each other even when we cannot be physically together. "With You" is more than just a saying — it is how we live, and it is the core of what makes Muddy York special.

### **#RUGBYFORALL**

We believe rugby is for everyone. Your support helps us to succeed in our mission of creating an accessible and inclusive space where people can learn and play, regardless of their financial situation. Inclusive rugby refers to creating a welcoming and accessible environment for all individuals to play and enjoy rugby, regardless of their background, abilities, gender, or financial status. It is about breaking down barriers — whether physical, social, or economic — so that everyone, from beginners to seasoned players, can get involved in the sport. It nurtures a mutual respect, understanding, and responsibility towards others. It helps to break down prejudices within sport and society at large.

At Muddy York, we believe in being truly inclusive, and we are one of the first **Mixed Abilities**-sanctioned teams in North America, and the only member club of the International Gay Rugby association with an officially sanctioned Mixed-Abilities team. Regardless of disability, age, gender, or background, we will work with anyone who wants to learn the sport to make sure they have the supports they need to be able to take part and be included.



## REACH AND IMPACT

#### **OUR REACH**

Muddy York is a club that does not exist in isolation, our members are not just from the downtown core, but our current and legacy members come from across the Greater Toronto Area and further. We are also a member of multiple governing bodies that exist at a local, provincial, national, and international level. As a club, our members take part in games & tournaments within our local union, but in addition to our local play, every year Muddy York members will travel to take part in tournaments across the globe. Muddy York also founded (and hosts) the annual **Beaver Bowl** rugby tournament, which welcomes teams and players from across all our governing bodies to take part.

By being a partner with Muddy York, you will have the opportunity to tap into these multiple levels of exposure. **Our governing bodies are:** 



The Toronto Rugby Union (TRU) is one of the largest and most established rugby organizations in Canada, representing over 40 clubs across the Greater Toronto Area. It oversees both competitive and recreational rugby, with a focus on community engagement and promoting the sport at all levels, from grassroots to elite athletes. The TRU has a significant reach, organizing many leagues, tournaments, and development programs, and serves as a key hub for rugby in Toronto, supporting over 10,000 players, coaches, spectators, and volunteers across the Greater Toronto Area.



The Ontario Rugby Union is the governing body for rugby in Ontario, overseeing the development and promotion of the sport across the province. It represents more than 120 clubs and thousands of players, coaches, and volunteers. The ORU organizes various competitions, including league play, tournaments, and provincial championships, and supports rugby development programs for all ages and skill levels. With a focus on growing rugby participation and fostering talent, the ORU plays a crucial role in the progression of rugby at both the grassroots and elite levels in Ontario.

International Gay Rugby is the global governing body for inclusive rugby, supporting and promoting rugby teams and clubs that welcome players of all sexual orientations and gender identities. Founded in 2001 as the International Gay Rugby Advisory Board, the IGR has grown to include 119 member clubs from across the world, providing a platform for 2SLGBTQ+ individuals and allies to engage in the sport in a safe, supportive, and inclusive environment. IGR organizes major events, such as:



#### **BINGHAM CUP**

The Bingham Cup has a significant global reach, growing from 8 American teams in the inaugural 2002 tournament in San Francisco, to 140 teams of players from North & South America, Europe, and Australasia in the 2024 tournament in Rome. Muddy York has played in every Bingham Cup since 2006 as either a full or partner team.

#### **NORAM CUP**

The NORAM Cup (IGR North American Championship) is a regional tournament that brings together inclusive rugby teams from North America every two years, and alternates with the Bingham Cup.

By supporting us, your brand will be displayed to not only the 1,200+ expected participants in the 2025 Boston tournament, but also a diverse and engaged audience, spanning from major urban centers to local communities from Boston to Vancouver to Dallas. The NORAM Cup has grown over the years, playing a key role in promoting rugby as a sport that values diversity and inclusion.

Muddy York gave me the space and time to grow the skills needed for a complex and physical game. I absolutely fell in love with it! On top of that, it's because of the people I have met. Rugby and my teammates have enriched my life immensely.

#### WHAT HAVE BEEN YOUR FAVOURITE MUDDY YORK HIGHLIGHTS?

Games and tournaments are always fun, but the highlight for me is that feeling of camaraderie that develops over time.

So many queer folks miss it growing up either due to fear, intimidation, or outright discrimination. Muddy York offers a place for us to grow together both as athletes and as people. We come to play rugby and end up as a chosen family.

My favourite Muddy York highlight was
Beaver Bowl and taking part in the team's
first women's game and the Mixed Abilities
showcase games. Additionally, finding that
Muddy York readily welcomes all people and
is accepting of people with disabilities was
a big thing.
